April 2, 2019 Endobronchial Ultrasounds – Pavlo Sakhatskyy, MD

Objectives: Review indications and rationale for CT screening of lung cancer including timing and indications for repeated imaging. Review options for invasive workup including CT guided biopsy, navigational bronchoscopy and bronchoscopy with EBUS. Review pre and post biopsy algorithm for management and include staging of lung cancer and implications for therapy.

Objectives: Outline evidence-based benefits of HRT. Identify potential risks of HRT including breast cancer survivors. Discuss current data on the cardiovascular effects of estrogen.
